

2018 SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES FOR APWU MEMBERS

There are six scholarships available for APWU members/students. Applications and instructions sheets for each are available in the APWU union office at the SNDC or the APWU office located at 1124 Berkshire Ave or apwusal.org for #1.

1. **APWU National: Deadline –extended to May 31, 2018.** 2 scholarships available. Please go to APWU.org for additional information and forms.

E.C. Hallbeck Scholarship Program: 1- \$2000 per year for 4 years (\$8000.00). 7 page instruction/application with essay and transcript requirement.

2016 Vocational Scholarship Program: 5- \$3000. 7 page instruction/application with essay and transcript.

2. **APWU of MA: Deadline- April 30, 2018.** 1- \$1000 for graduating High School senior. Essay on labor related subject and transcript required.
3. **APW-ABA Scholarship Program in honor of Thomas Hartos, Michael Tosches, & Eugene Johnson: Deadline- May 15, 2018.** 1-\$1000 scholarship for graduating high school senior. Simple “luck of the draw” rules.
4. **Pioneer Valley Central Labor Council, AFL-CIO Scholarship: Deadline – May 31, 2018.** 6-\$500 scholarships for graduating high school seniors. 2-\$500 scholarships for continuing education. Essay and transcript required.
5. **APWU Local 497 Annual Scholarship in honor of Jim Connors and Bob Caracciolo: Deadline-June 21, 2018.** 8-\$500 scholarships for full time students. Simple “luck of the draw “rules.

- 6. Gerard L. Pellegrini Scholarship: Deadline –May 31, 2018. 4-\$1000 scholarship for students attending college. 2-\$500 scholarship for building trades apprenticeship. A written essay is required along with additional requirements.**
